Bill Summary

A bill to amend the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, by repealing Section [56-1-1750](#) relating to a moped driver's license.

REVENUE IMPACT ^{1/}

This bill would have no impact on state revenues in FY2008-09.

Explanation

This bill repeals a Code section in Article 9 that would not require a photograph of a moped licensee under an obsolete reference to an obsolete section, 56-1-150.

Requirements to operate a moped license conform to basic standards to apply for a driver's license in this State under Article 1, Chapter 1 of Title 56. A driver's license must bear on it a laminated colored photograph of the licensee under Section 56-1-140. Repeal of Section 56-1-1750 thus eliminates reference for authority to not require a photograph under a nonexistent statute, Section 56-1-150. Since Section 56-1-1750 does not apply to any fee, its elimination would not impact state revenues in FY 2008-09.
